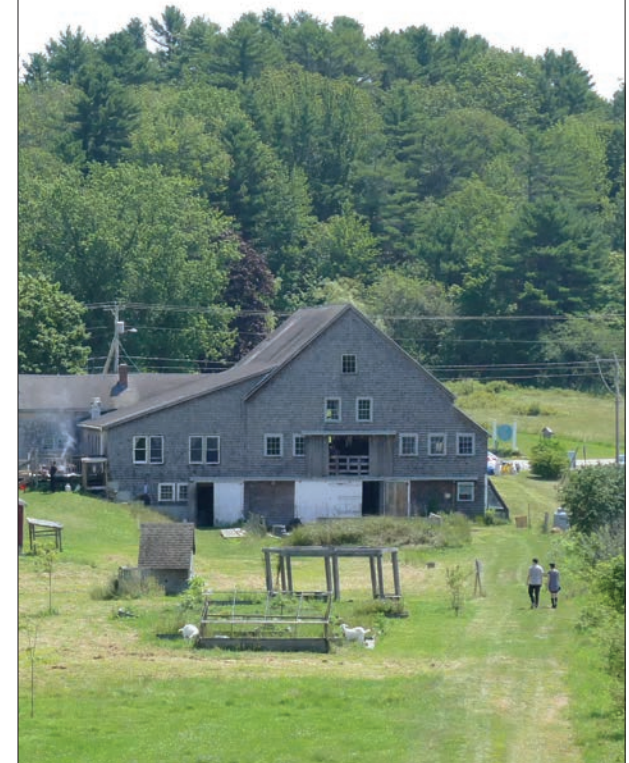

WHAT IS THE MORRIS FARM TRUST?

A DEMONSTRATION FARM

We are an educational non-profit dedicated to preserving our 50-acre farm:

- » We're designated a "Forever Farm" by the Maine Farmland Trust.
- » We act as an incubator for new farmers.
- » We help Slow Money Maine provide funds for local farmers as the Lincoln County fiscal agent.
- » Our resident farmer, Lost and Found Farm, grows flowers, herbs and vegetables.
- » We provide a local farmer with pasture for his cows and sheep, and hay from our fields.
- » Our Master Gardeners grow for local food pantries.
- » Our Margaret Ellis Community Garden provides garden space for local residents to "grow your own."
